



From The Apostle's Heart

Beloved in Christ,

Happy New Year! As we begin 2026, it's the perfect time to reflect on our spiritual direction. In a world overflowing with distractions—news, social media, endless to-do lists—it's easy to lose sight of what truly matters: our relationship with God.

This month, we're diving into the theme of spiritual focus. Fixing our eyes on Jesus isn't about withdrawing from life's responsibilities; it's about intentionally placing Him at the center of everything we do. When we focus on Christ, we gain clarity, peace, and strength to walk the narrow way, no matter what the year brings.

Scripture Feature

"Let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith." - Hebrews 12:1-2

This passage reminds us that the Christian life is a marathon, not a sprint. We're called to run with perseverance, but the only way to finish strong is by keeping our eyes on Jesus. The world offers countless distractions, but only He can guide us safely to the finish line.

The Battle for Our Focus

Distraction is one of the enemy's most effective tools. It doesn't always come as obvious sin; sometimes, it's busyness, worry, or even "good" things that pull us away from God's best.

Jesus said:

"But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well." (Matthew 6:33)

Common Distractions:

Technology & social media

Worrying about the future

Overcommitment

Unhealthy relationships

Past regrets or future anxieties

Spiritual Drift:

Like a boat untethered from its anchor, we can drift away from God without even realizing it.

The further we drift, the harder it is to return—unless we intentionally refocus on Christ.

Biblical Examples of Focus

1. Mary & Martha (Luke 10:38-42):

Martha was busy serving, but Mary chose to sit at Jesus' feet. Jesus commended Mary for choosing "what is better"—time in His presence.

2. Peter Walking on Water (Matthew 14:28-31):

As long as Peter looked at Jesus, he walked on water. When he focused on the wind and waves, he began to sink. Our focus determines our direction!

Practical Strategies for Staying Focused

1. Start Your Day with God

Begin each morning in prayer and Scripture. Dedicate the day to Him and seek His guidance.



2. Eliminate Spiritual Clutter

Identify and remove distractions that pull you away from God—whether it’s social media, unhealthy habits, or negative influences.

3. Set Boundaries

Like Jesus, withdraw to “quiet places” for prayer (Luke 5:16). Schedule regular time for devotion.

4. Surround Yourself with Encouragement

Engage with a community of believers who inspire and challenge you to stay focused on your faith.

5. Meditate on God’s Promises

Reflect on verses that remind you of God’s love, provision, and purpose. Anchor your thoughts in Him.
